A note from Pastor Corey Miller...

When I first started at Waterdam Church in 2013, I remember walking into my first Youth Sunday School class and there were three students in the room. I introduced myself and waited for the rest of students to arrive, only to discover that these were the only students in class that day. Almost five years later, we now have two separate Jr. High and Sr. High Sunday School classes, both averaging about ten students. We have seen a similar pattern of growth in our midweek gatherings. It has been encouraging to see how God is blessing our Youth Ministry. As Illuminate Youth Ministries continues to grow, I can see many great opportunities coming alongside of our new building. I would like to share with you the main ones:

Connection To The Church

Currently, all our Wednesday Night gatherings take place in "The Workshop". For those who are unaware, The Workshop is the small building across the street and next door to the Church Offices. It has been great to have a place for the Youth to call their own, but the physical distance from The Workshop and the Church Building can create a metaphorical distance in our congregation. Being able to meet in the same building as the rest of our ministries will bridge that gap and bring us together under the overall ministry of Waterdam Church.

Increase Ministry Opportunities

With the creation of a Fellowship Hall/Multi-Purpose Room, the Youth Ministry will be able to have more diverse types of events. This would include but is not limited to events centered around games, music, food, and sports. This provides an ability to reach teens of different demographics and backgrounds, all of which have a wide array of interests.

Becoming The "Third Place"



More Comfort


